<p>Student Eligibility</p>	<p>Any high school student in the state of Utah 10th-12th grade who demonstrates leadership qualities, high academic achievement, and exemplary citizenship. Students must have a 3.0 or higher GPA with No F's.</p>
<p>How to Apply</p>	<p>Interested students must complete the attached application and provide the requested information. The application may also be accessed by visiting https://uassp.org/ All applications must be postmarked or submitted by March 1st. If there are questions, please contact Melissa Judy at 435-851-6843. <p>COST</p>	<p>There will be a \$100 fee to be a UASC officer- Due by April 22, 2026. UASC student officers will be responsible to attend & present for 1 day of the USULC Conference at USU or the Dixie Leadership Conference at Utah Tech University- whichever conference is geographically closest to where the state officer lives. Each officer will be responsible for travel to & from and meals for the day. We highly encourage all state officers to attend the National Vision Conference held in Pinkerton, New Hampshire, cost will be approximately \$1600.00 (Non-Refundable) , June 21-25, 2026.</p>
<p>Notification</p>	<p>Semi-finalists will be notified by March 15, 2026, and will be invited for a virtual interview with members of the UASSP/UASC Board in mid March/early April. Notification of state officer positions will be sent by April 15th. Up to 15 students will be chosen as a state officer.</p>
<p>Commitment</p>	<p>All selected students will be presented, along with their parents, at a Mandatory UASC Meet and Greet on April 22, 2026.</p>

It is the mission of the Utah Association of Student Councils to provide training and support to Utah's secondary school leaders; to be a resource to facilitate networking among students, advisors, and administrators.

As a UASC State Officer, you will have many opportunities and responsibilities. Officers need to be dedicated and organized in order to be successful in school and as an officer. The primary responsibilities of the UASC Officers are outlined below.

- **Academic Grades:** A minimum Grade Point Average of 3.0 (B) for each term as an officer. No "F" grades are allowed. All officers must be full time students at their respective schools (usually 6 or more full credit classes).
- **Citizenship/Attendance:** A student officers should be a student in good standing at their school in attendance, tardiness and overall citizenship as determined by their administration. If grades are awarded, students must maintain satisfactory citizenship grades. An officer may not receive any "U" or be deemed unsatisfactory in citizenship once selected or they will be dismissed.
- **Principal's Conferences :** State officers are asked to attend and assist at a variety of conferences hosted by the UASSP Board. Additionally, Officers will teach & facilitate regional leadership trainings/conferences around the state.
- **Leadership Training:** All state officers must be available to attend the National Vision Conference in Pinkerton, New Hampshire (June 21-25, 2026). Cost is approximately \$1600.00- paid by student.
- **Meetings:** State Office will be expected to attend monthly meetings via zoom.
- **In School Visits:** State Officers will travel to schools in their area, to talk with councils about leadership and activities at their schools.

We have read and understand the responsibilities of participating as a UASC State Officer. I am willing to participate in, organize, and support the activities outlined above and in the application. I will conduct myself in a manner befitting a student leader knowing I am representing myself, my family, my school, and the UASC.
